In the Kitchen

Latkes for Hannukah

- 2 cups grated mature potatoes
- 3 or more teaspoons (to taste) grated onion (helps keep the potatoes from turning dark)
- 3 beaten eggs
- 1 ½ tablespoons flour
- 1 ½ teaspoons salt
- Dash of pepper if desired


In a bowl, mix grated potatoes and onion, then place on paper towels and wring out as much moisture as you can Return to bowl and stir in beaten eggs
Sift flour and salt and add to potato, onion, egg mixture
Mix lightly with hands
Immediately shape into ¼ in thick pancakes—about 3 inches across for large ones, or 1 inch across for appetizer size, if preferred
Sauté in ¼ inch or more hot vegetable oil
Turn when bottom is brown and crispy and sauté other side to match Serve hot with applesauce and sour cream
