## COVID-19 UPDATE



We know it's a repetitious message, but ever more important to keep focused on the BIG FIVE:

- Limit trips outside the home
- Wear a mask when around others
- Keep at least six feet away from others
- Avoid indoor gatherings
- Wash your hands frequently!

Because of the risk of our hospitals being overwhelmed in the current and anticipated surge of COVID-19 cases, the County (and surrounding Bay Area counties) issued a new stay-at-home order last week, which is scheduled to go into effect today, Tuesday, December 8th. The order closes certain businesses and reduces the capacity limits for others and strongly encourages all to stay home! You can read the order <u>here</u>.

Today at noon, the state is hosting a "Virtual Grand Rounds" presentation on the COVID-19 surge. Presenters are physicians that hold central roles in our national COVID-19 response: Eric Goosby, MD, Professor of Medicine, University of California, San Francisco (UCSF), and Seema Jain, MD, Chief, Disease Investigations Section for the Infectious Diseases Branch, California Department of Public Health (CDPH). The presentation is free. <u>Register here</u>. Marin County Public Health officers will also host a Zoom community conversation this week on the current COVID situation in Marin, on Thursday, December 10, 2:00 – 3:00pm.
