

Plus, throughout March the Opera will be hosting a diverse array of immersive events including lively panel discussions and events. Timeframe is March 5 – 8, 2021. Festival events (other than the operas themselves) require a pass which costs \$99 (\$69 for current subscribers and donors of at least \$75).


