FIRESafe MARIN Home Hardening Workshop

November 19; 6:30 to 8:30

Free seminar hosted by FIRESafe MARIN on home hardening against fire.

FIRESafe MARIN has developed a seminar and training curriculum to introduce homeowners to these concepts.

Taught by experts in the field of wildfire, home hardening, and building science, this seminar will help Marin homeowners to:

- Identify their home's vulnerabilities to wildfires and embers
- Introduce ignition and ember resistant design and materials
- Provide home-hardening and retrofitting resources
- Encourage building modifications to reduce the likelihood of structural ignitions during wildfires
- Manufacturer representatives will be on-site to display fire-resistant building materials

Weather permitting, a live fire demonstration will be conducted at 5 PM to demonstrate the differences between fire-resistant and ordinary construction.
