The NWP Railroad Trail runs an arrow-straight paved and level course through Larkspur and Corte Madera. Its name is derived from the railroad that once made use of this corridor: the

Northwestern Pacific Railroad whisked passengers on its electric line between Sausalito and San Anselmo until the early 40s. We will do an out-and-back 2.5 miles walk starting in Corte Madera into Larkspur. Since this is out-and-back, you may end your walk whenever you wish at one of the many benches along the trail.
